Titled *In A Nutshell*, an ensemble cast will perform scenes and speeches from some of Bell Shakespeare Artistic Director Peter Evans' favourite plays.

Offering a look into Peter Evans' personal thoughts on Shakespeare as he offers his own commentary, the production features scenes showcasing the imagination and linguistic magic of Shakespeare. Evans will explore key themes from power to love and forgiveness across some of Shakespeare's best-known plays, ultimately giving an intimate and inspiring look at humanity.

Peter Evans, Artistic Director of Bell Shakespeare, said: "More than 30 years after John Bell founded Bell Shakespeare, it is an incredible feeling to finally be in our permanent home and welcome the public into our brandnew theatre space, The Neilson Nutshell. This production is a perfect way to showcase how this space is ushering in a new era for us as a company, with the ability to stage new work and continue to explore Shakespeare's enduring relevance."

The ensemble cast will skillfully switch between characters and scenes from a variety of plays, including *Romeo and Juliet, A Midsummer Night's Dream, Twelfth Night, Macbeth, King Lear* and *As You Like It,* bringing to life Shakespeare's words.
